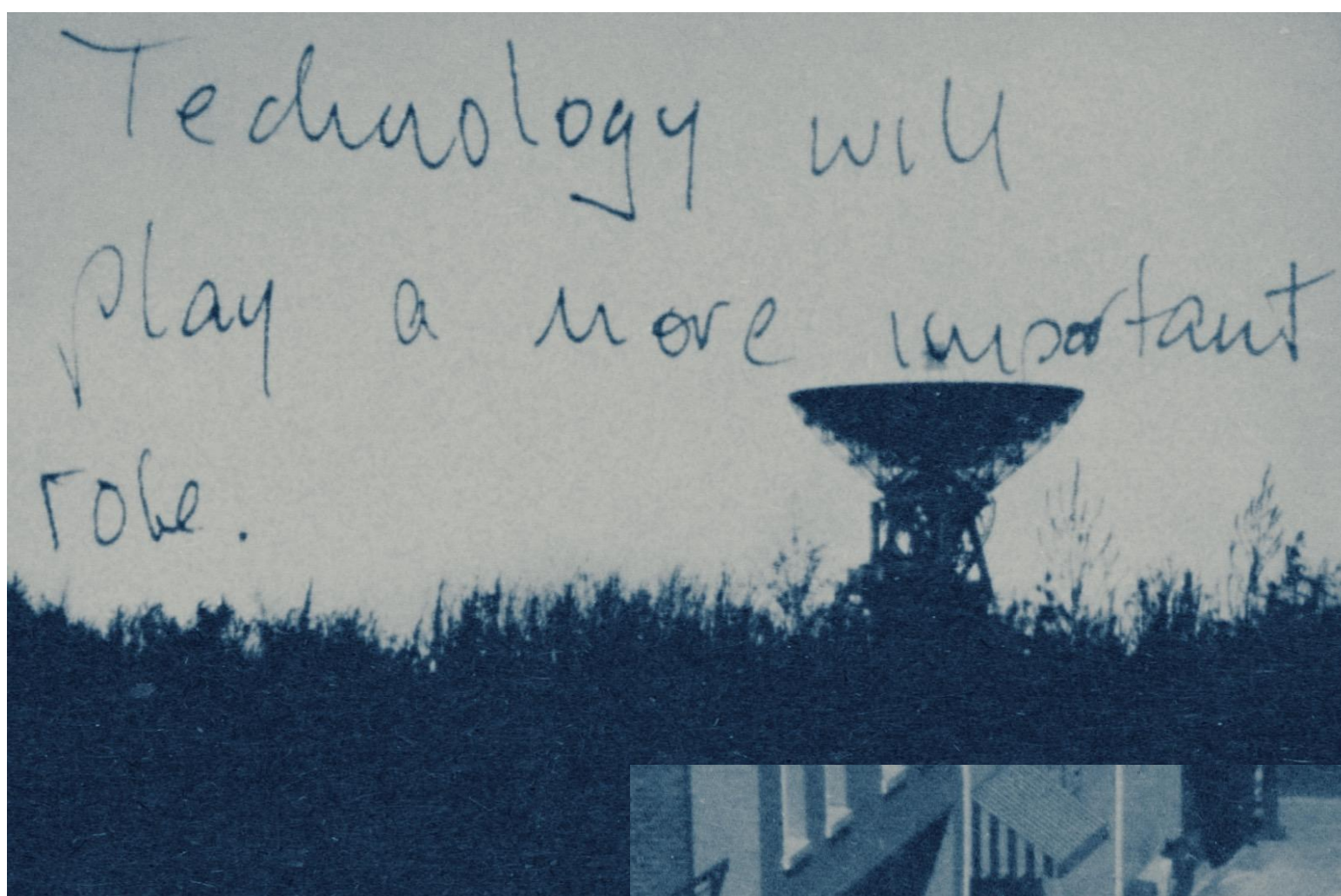


Public Station

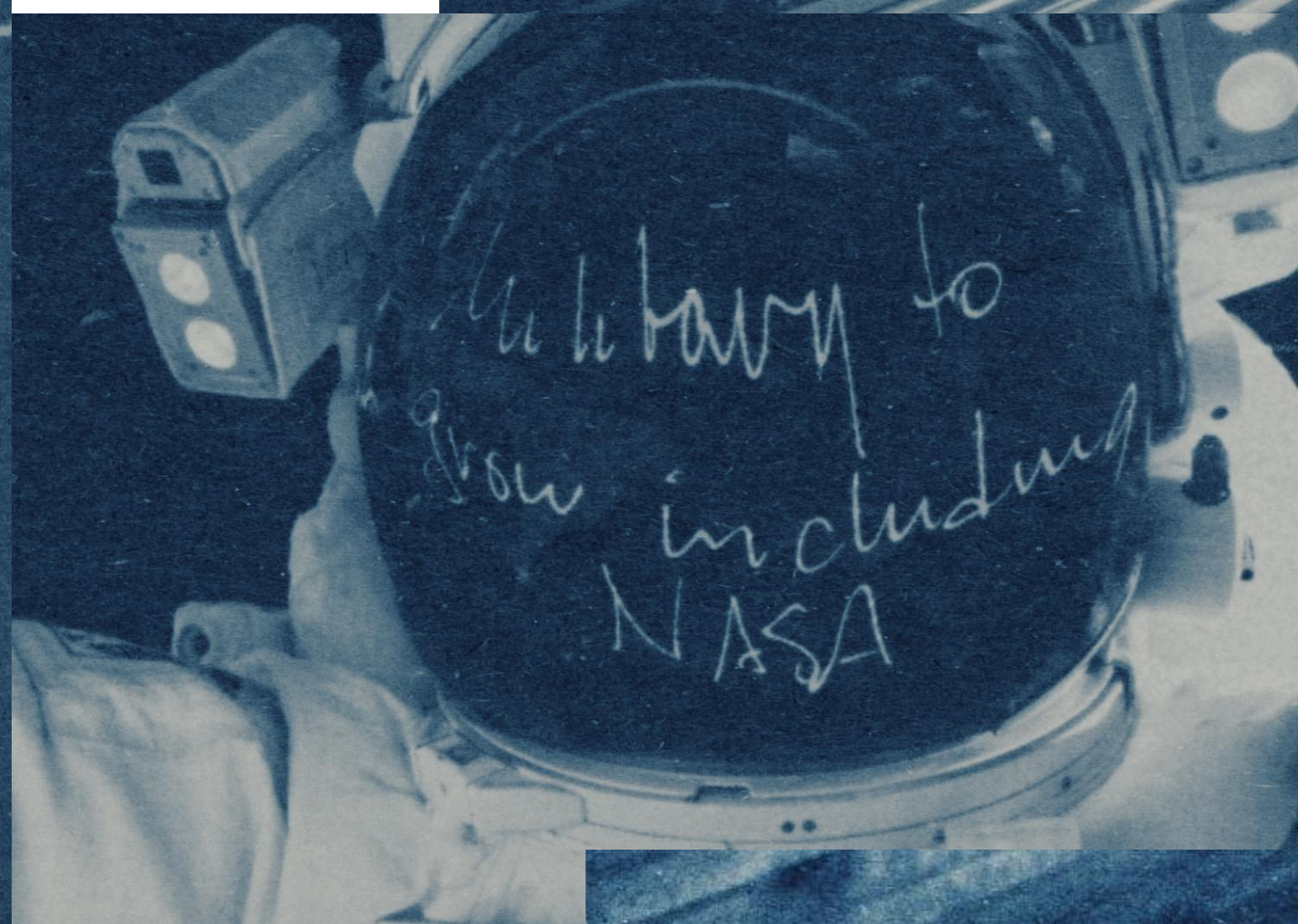
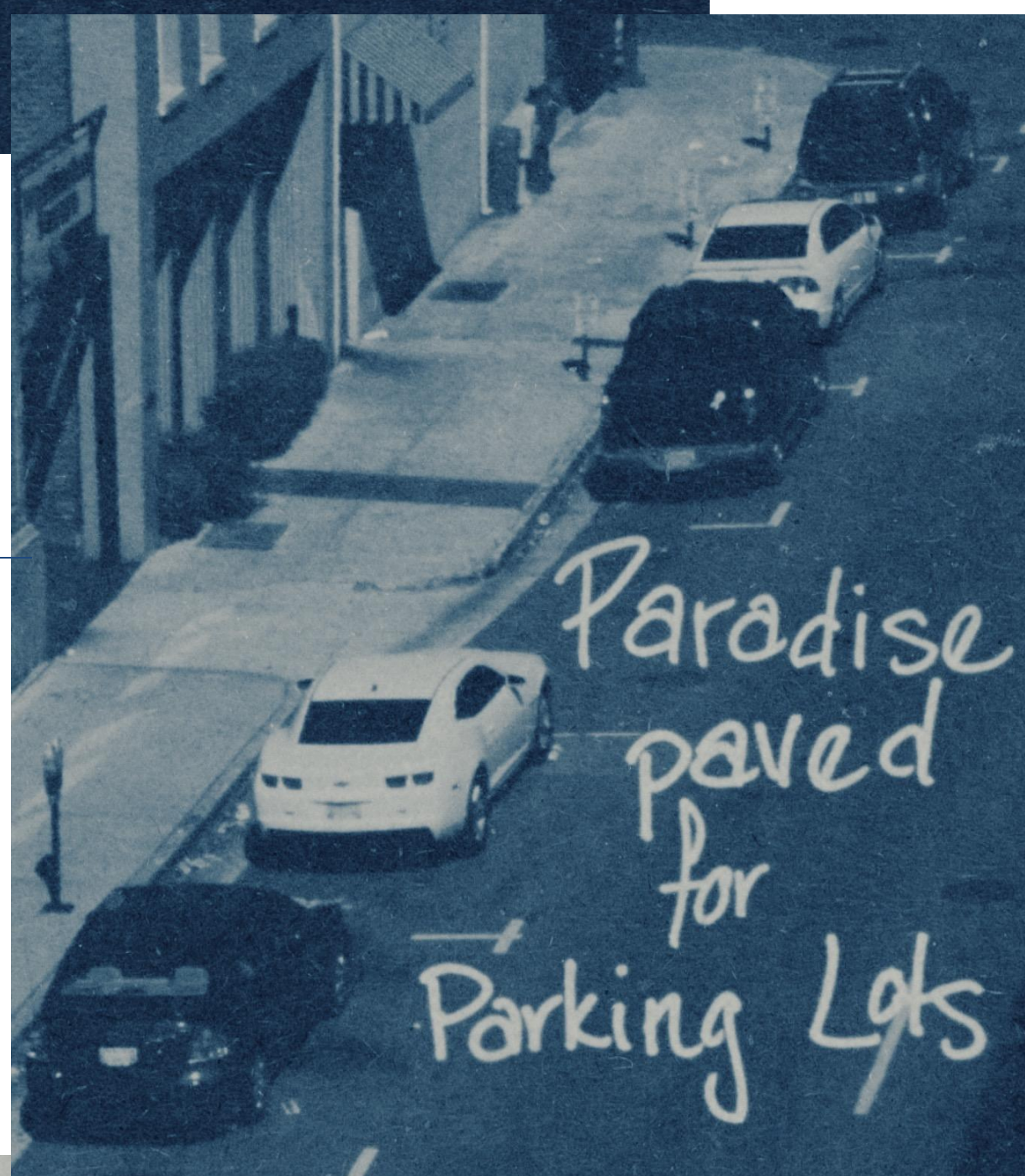


"Technology will play a more important role."

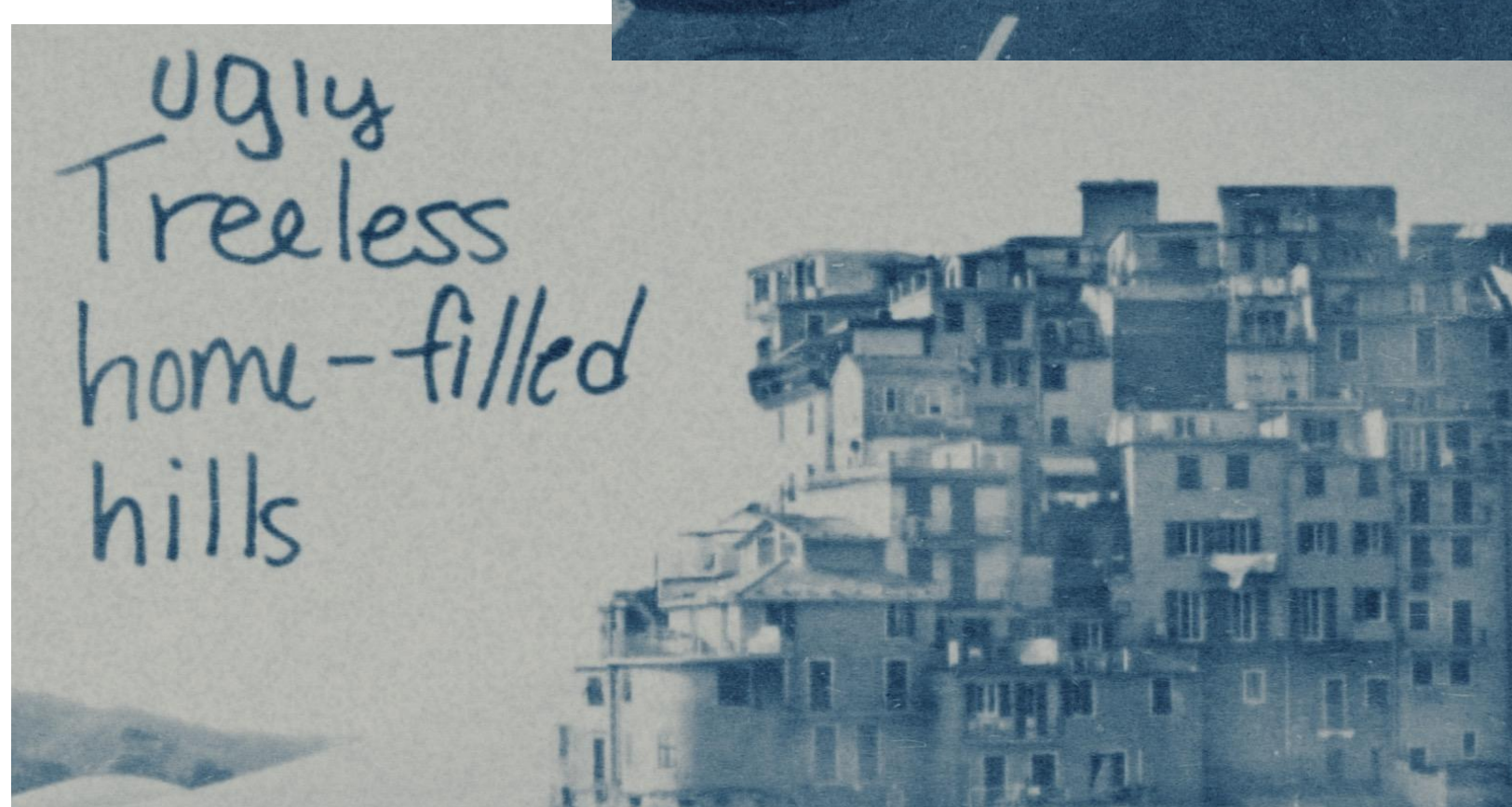


"Lasers"
