**Satellite Registration** is available to students within their Academic Advisement Centers.

Administrative Science students should register in ASB 102; Engineering students should register in EB 158; Nursing students should register in NB 207; Science, Liberal Arts, Undecided and Graduate students should register in the University Center.

Priority Registration is your chance as an **enrolled student** to obtain the classes you want first. **Remember to register during Priority Registration.**

Telephone registration is coming. **Anticipated arrival Spring 1997!** A new heading for the courses is listed as "Call Number". This five-digit number will be needed when telephone registration is activated. You may use the five-digit call number now on the registration form or you can continue using the course prefix and section number.

The revised exam schedule for Spring is also listed near the end of this issue of the timetable.

Beginning in July, 1996, the telephone prefix for UAH will change to **890-XXXX**.

Lab charges are listed near the end of this issue of the timetable.

## REGISTRATION

### PRIORITY REGISTRATION (APRIL 1 - 11)

All currently enrolled students are asked to register for classes during Priority Registration. Registration forms will be mailed to each student currently enrolled. Each student should complete the registration form and obtain appropriate signatures if needed before submitting registration forms for processing.

Re-entry and newly admitted students are asked to register during Open Registration, May 2 - 10, UC 112. Re-entering students who are in good academic standing may register during Open Registration if a re-entry application is on file in the Office of Admissions prior to May 2, 1996.

### Academic Advisement

Academic Advisement is **REQUIRED** for most students. See Academic Advising Section. Registrations **WILL NOT** be processed without the appropriate advisor signature.

Schedule adjustments may be made anytime during the Open Registration period of each semester.

**OPEN REGISTRATION (May 2 - 10)** Students who missed priority registration or did not attend Orientation may register for classes at this time. Hours: 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m., University Center, room 112.

### SCHEDULE ADJUSTMENTS

Students who register during Priority or Open Registration may add or drop courses prior to the first day of class without paying a schedule adjustment fee.



## **LATE REGISTRATION**

Late registration will be May 10. All fees are due and payable at time of registration for those choosing to register during late registration.

## **ACADEMIC ADVISING**

Each student has the primary responsibility for planning their own academic program and scheduling courses. Academic advice from faculty members is available to any student seeking such assistance. Appointments are scheduled through the academic department offices and should be done well in advance of registration to allow time to discuss interests and goals.

**Satellite Registration is available to students within their Academic Advisement Centers. Administrative Science students should register in ASB 102; Engineering students should register in EB 158; Nursing students should register in NB 201; Science, Liberal Arts, Undecided and Graduate students should register in the University Center.**

Advisor Approval on Registration Form is Required as Follows:

**Academic Advisement Center**, University Center room 118 (895-6290). Freshmen registration forms must be approved by a faculty advisor in the Advisement Center (Nursing, Engineering, and Administrative Science freshmen see appropriate sections).

Conditional/Probational student registration forms must be approved by a faculty advisor in the Advisement Center.

Sophomore registration forms for students in the College of Liberal Arts, and the College of Science, who have not declared a major through having a Program of Study completed, must be approved in the Advisement Center.

**College of Nursing**, Nursing Building room 207, (895-6742). Registration forms for all students in the College of Nursing must bear the approval stamp of the Nursing Advisement Office.

**College of Engineering**, Engineering Building, room 158, (895-6877). All Engineering students will be advised whether planning to register during early, open or on final registration day. Your advisor will discuss your proposed course selections with you. Advisor's signature must be on the form to be processed.

Freshmen, Sophomores, First Term Transfers: Advisement will be held in the Engineering Advisement Center, Engineering Building, room 158, each day of priority registration from 12:00 (noon) until 6:00 p.m. You do not have to have an appointment.

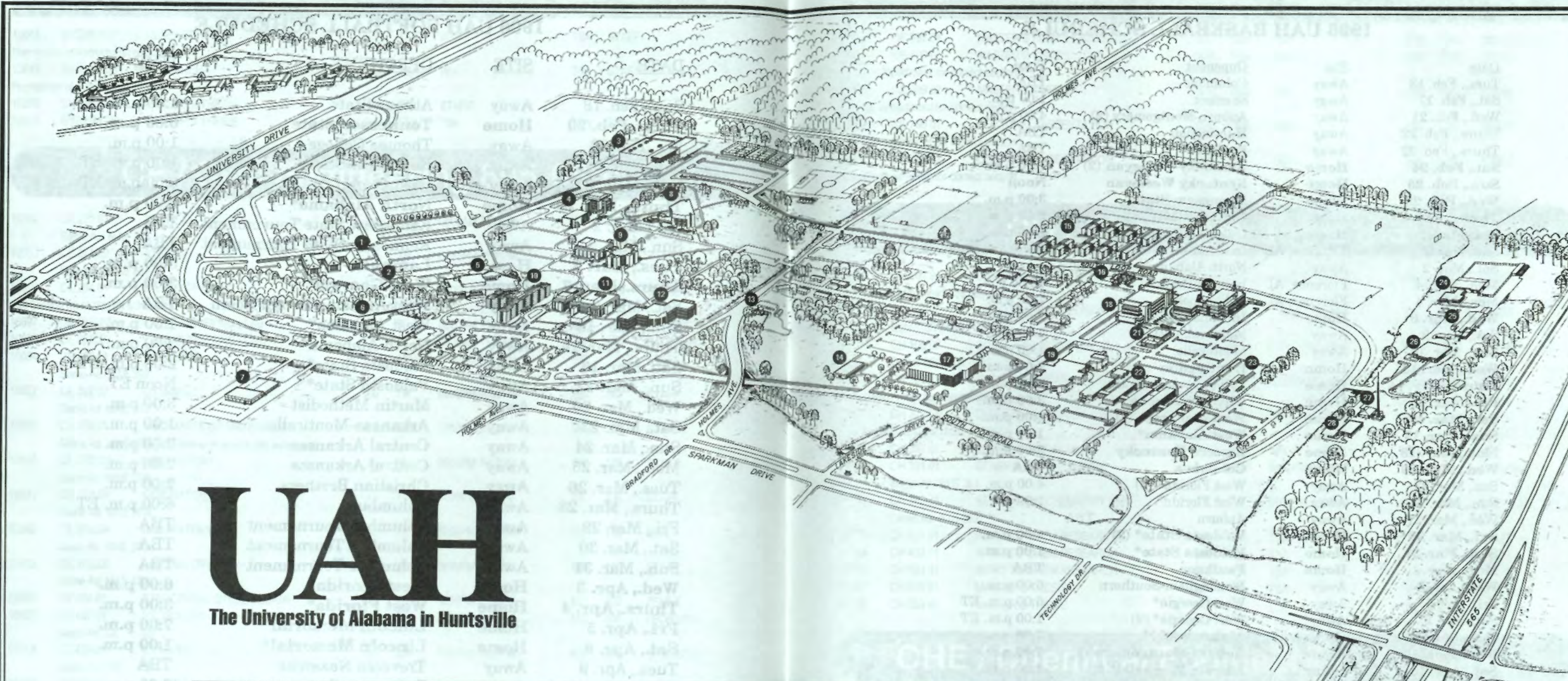

### HOUSING CHARGES

Students assigned to suites (Central Campus Residence Hall or Southeast Housing) must pay the full semester's rent at the beginning of the semester. A student who fails to complete payment of fees due or fails to file a deferred payment request with the Cashier's Office by the close of registration for any particular semester will have their registration canceled. (Deferred Payment Plan not available Summer Semester) Students assigned to private apartments (family units in Southeast Housing) may pay their rent in equal installments on a monthly basis. Rent payments are due the first day of each month.

All freshmen residents of Central Campus Residence Hall are required to purchase a Food Contract which is due with rent at the beginning of each semester.

If a student officially withdraws from the University while residing in University Housing, he/she may qualify for a prorated refund of rent. This is determined by the date of the student resident's official check-out from housing.

### Academic Information

#### COURSE LOAD

Undergraduate students: The minimum number of hours for full-time enrollment is 12 semester hours. The normal (average) course load is 15 to 16 semester hours for full-time students. Permission to take more than 20 hours must be obtained from the Student's Dean.

Graduate students: Nine semester hours constitutes a full-time load. Permission to take more than 13 hours must be obtained by the Student's Dean.

#### COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM

The number of a course is indicative of its academic level. Courses numbered 100-400 are undergraduate level; 500 level courses may be utilized for undergraduate or graduate credit, depending upon the department. Courses numbered 600 or above are graduate level courses.

#### PREREQUISITES

Students are responsible for knowing and meeting prerequisites for a course. Prerequisites are listed in the catalog under the course name and number.

#### GRADES

The student assumes special responsibilities whenever a grade of "T" or "X" is received. See the UAH catalog for details. For the purpose of determining academic status of those students on academic probation, a grade of "T" or "X" will be treated as a "F".



## **GRADUATION**

Students planning to graduate at the close of the semester must apply for graduation no later than the time of the registration for the given semester.

## **STUDENT WITH DISABILITIES**

Students with disabilities are advised to register early. Newly admitted disabled students should contact the Office of Admissions (895-6070) or the Office of Student Development Services (895-6203) for special consideration.

## **PARKING AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS (895-6594)**

All faculty and staff who operate or park a motor vehicle on the University of Alabama in Huntsville campuses must register their vehicle with the Office of Public Safety, Physical Plant Building, South Loop Road. Faculty/staff may register their vehicle(s) through campus mail or in person at the Office of Public Safety.

The following information is needed for faculty/staff to register their vehicle:

1. Vehicle make, model, color and year
2. Current driver's license number
3. Vehicle tag number

Students will be assessed a vehicle registration fee (\$5.00) which will be added to their tuition statement. Students who wish to register additional vehicles must go the Office of Public Safety. A fee (\$3.00) will be charged for each of the next two vehicles.
