### Academic Advising

Each student has the primary responsibility for planning his/her own academic program (consult the UAH catalog for prerequisites) and scheduling courses. Academic advice from faculty members is available to any student seeking such assistance. Appointments are scheduled through the academic department offices and should be done well in advance of registration to allow time to discuss interests and goals.

Satellite registration is available to students within their Academic Advisement Centers.  
**See "Registration Sites" for registration hours.**

Advisor approval on registration form is required as follows:

**Academic Advisement Center**, University Center, Room 118, 890-6290. Freshmen in the College of Liberal Arts and Science must have registration forms approved by a faculty advisor in the Advisement Center. (Nursing, Engineering, and Administrative Science freshmen see appropriate sections) Conditional/Probational student registration forms must be approved by a faculty advisor in the Advisement Center.

Sophomore registration forms for students in the College of Liberal Arts, and the College of Science who have not declared a major and completed a Program of Study must be approved in the Advisement Center. All physics majors are required to have registration forms approved by the Physics Dept, Optics Building, Room 201-C, (890-6276, ext. 273).

**College of Administrative Science**, Administrative Science Building, Room 102 (890-6024). Registration forms for all students in the College of Administrative Science must bear the signature approval of the Academic Assistance Office.

**College of Engineering**, Engineering Building, Room 158, (890-6877). All first and second year engineering students along with first term transfer students will be advised in the College of Engineering Advisement Center. Third and fourth year students who have been assigned a departmental advisor are asked to make appointments with their advisor prior to Priority Registration to discuss their schedule. All Engineering graduate students need to obtain the appropriate signature before registering. Both graduate and under-



graduate student registration forms will be processed in the Engineering Building, Room 139.

### Registration Information

All currently enrolled students are asked to register for classes during Priority Registration. Registration forms will be mailed to each student currently enrolled. Each student should complete the registration form and obtain the appropriate signatures if needed before submitting registration forms for processing.

Re-entry students should complete the necessary paperwork in the Office of Admissions, University Center Room 124, prior to Open Registration. Newly admitted students should contact their advisement office for appropriate procedures to follow before registering.

Schedule adjustments may be made anytime during the Open Registration period. No schedule adjustments will be made during the Priority Registration period. Students who register during Priority or Open Registration may add or drop courses prior to the first day of class.

Open Registration allows students who missed Priority Registration or those students who did not attend Orientation a time to register. Hours of registration vary depending on the registration site. See "Registration Sites" in this publication.

### **Financial Aid**

Students who are receiving financial aid are responsible for completing the necessary paperwork far enough in advance to assure the proper credits to their accounts. If you have questions, please check with the Office of Financial Aid, UC 124, or the Cashier's Office, UC 213.

**Financial Aid application completion deadline for Summer Sessions is April 1.**

### **Housing Charges**

Students assigned to suites (Central Campus Residence Hall or Southeast Housing) must pay the entire semester's rent at the beginning of the semester. A student who fails to complete payment of fees due or fails to file a payment deferment request with the Cashier's Office by the close of registration for any particular semester will have their registration canceled. Students assigned to private apartments (family units in Southeast Housing) may pay their rent in equal installments on a monthly basis. Rent payments are due the first day of the month. Student should check with the Housing Offices concerning other charges and/or fees related to Housing.

**Residency:** Residency is determined by information submitted on the application for admission. Request for a change in residency status should be filed in writing with the Office of the Assistant Vice-President for Enrollment Services, UC 119, with appropriate documentation prior to the first day of class.

## **Academic Information**

**Course Load - Undergraduate students:** Twelve semester hours constitutes a full-time load.

Permission to take more than 20 hours must be obtained from the student's Dean.

**Graduate students:** Nine semester hours constitutes a full-time load. Permission to take more than 13 hours must be obtained from the student's Dean.

**Course Numbering System -** The number of a course is indicative of its academic level.

Courses numbered 100-400 are undergraduate level; 500 level courses may be utilized for undergraduate or graduate credit, depending upon the department. Courses numbered 600 or above are graduate level courses.

**Course Repeat -** Students should be aware that course repeats, for any reason, may not be looked upon favorably by some employers and by professional schools. Hence course repeats should be avoided. After seeking counsel of an academic advisor, students may repeat any course an unlimited number of times in order to achieve a passing grade or an improved understanding.

A maximum of five course repeats may be excluded from the calculation of the student's Grade Point Average. The student must declare the course repeats before the end of the regular registration period for the semester in which the course will be repeated. Only courses for which the student has received a grade of C, D, or F may be repeated under this option. When withdrawing from a course that has been declared as a course repeat the previous grade will still be used in the computation of the GPA and the course will not count toward the maximum of five repeats. Each time a student repeats a course counts against the maximum of five such repeats, under this option. Students may use all five repeats in a single course or in five separate courses or any combination of separate courses and multiple repeats of single courses. Until a grade other than W is reported, the previous grade will be used for the GPA. The transcript will show both the original grades and the course repeat grades, but only the grade points and credit hours earned in the repeated courses will count toward graduation and will be averaged into the



student's Grade Point Average. Concurrent registration for multiple sections of a course is not allowed.

For all other courses repeated at UAH, both the original grade and the course repeat grade will show on the transcript and will be calculated in the student's grade point average. *Students are not allowed to repeat courses for which they have higher level credit. For example, a student can not repeat MA 119 when they have credit for calculus.*

A student wishing to exercise the Course Repeat Option must file the intent to do so in the Office of Records, (UC 116) before the end of registration.

REVISED POLICY 08-20-97

**Grades** - Students may receive their grades through a touch tone telephone and a convenient 1-800 number (1-800-528-3408). Grades will be available to you 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, starting 24 hours after the last final exam. You will be mailed a grade report after final examinations end. The student assumes special responsibilities whenever a grade of "I" or "X" is received. See the UAH catalog for details. For the purpose of determining academic status of those students on academic probation, a grade of "I" or "X" will be treated as an "F".

**Graduation** - Students planning to graduate at the close of the semester must apply for graduation no later than the time of the registration for the given semester.

**Prerequisites** - Students are responsible for knowing and meeting prerequisites for a course. Prerequisites are listed in the catalog under the course name and number.

## Parking and Traffic Regulations (890-6594)

Students will be assessed a vehicle registration fee which will be added to their tuition statement. Students who wish to register additional vehicles must go to the Office of Public Safety. A fee will be charged for each of the next two vehicles. Fees are prorated for Summer term.

## Students with Disabilities

Students with disabilities are advised to register during Priority Registration. Newly admitted students with disabilities should contact the Office of Admissions (890-6070) or the Office of Student Development Services (890-6203) for special consideration.

If you do not wish the University to release the foregoing "directory information" concerning you, you must check the block provided on the registration form. This option must be renewed by the same means for each subsequent semester.

Information about you other than that listed above will not be released to third parties unless you specifically authorize such disclosure and unless the ACT otherwise permits this to be done.
